<u>APPLICATIONS FOR AMUSEMENT WITH PRIZE MACHINE PERMITS SECTION 34, GAMING ACT 1968</u>	<p>The Licensing and Environmental Committee determined an application for a Permit for Amusement with Prize Machines and also sought approval for the policy issues detailed in the recommendation below.</p> <p>The Council is recommended that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. In future, all applications requesting the installation of more than 2 Amusement with Prize Machines on licensed premises come before the Licensing and Environmental Committee or Licensing Sub-Committee for decision as to grant.2. All future applications for 2 or less Amusement with Prizes Machines on licensed premises be determined by the Head of Planning, Health and Environment or the Environmental Health and Licensing Manager.3. The fee for such Permits be £32.4.
