1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To consider requests from KD15 Scouts and Far Forest Scouts for Grants to assist with the purchase of equipment and renovation of their Buildings.

- 3.1 Council on 23rd February 2005, agreed as part of the Budget Process, a Budget Allocation of £1,000 to provide Grants to Voluntary Organisations in order to Pump Prime projects.
- 3.2 Requests have been received from KD15 Scouts and Far Forest Scouts (copies included as Appendices 1 and 2) for a Grant towards their costs of purchasing equipment and renovating their Buildings.
