

Proposed structure for the Climate Change Strategy.

The Worcestershire Climate Change Strategy is currently being reviewed. It is proposed that the structure will remain the same as the existing strategy, as outlined below. It is envisaged that the Wyre Forest Climate Change Strategy will provide a local delivery framework for the county strategy and will therefore follow same structure. Annual action plans will also be developed to deliver the strategies.
