'Connecting' Kidderminster Regeneration Prospectus Adoption Document

Members considered a briefing paper and presentation from the Regeneration and Economic Prosperity Manager detailing ideas generated through consultation with the public and key stakeholders on the development of a Regeneration Prospectus for Kidderminster.

The Committee were pleased to welcome pupils from King Charles I School who had worked with Council Officers on the development of the regeneration prospectus. Pupils did a brief presentation to Members on what they liked about Kidderminster and which areas could be improved.

Members noted that a wide variety of comments had been submitted on the prospectus that had helped to shape and refine the document. It was also recognised that the prospectus would be a 'living' document and adaptable to changes and developments in the Town.
