**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER UNDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119**

**WYRE FOREST DISTRICT COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS, No. 569 (PART)
BEWDLEY) DIVERSION ORDER 2009**

This Order is made by Wyre Forest District Council (“The Authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The owner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

The Worcestershire County Council has been consulted and the [*name of Authorities*] have consented to the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Bewdley and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after [] days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. [Notwithstanding this Order [*name of statutory undertakers*] shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: [*e.g. to install, maintain or alter apparatus*]].
3. There shall at the end of [] days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Bewdley described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

That part of Footpath No. 569 commencing in the Parish of Bewdley at the junction with the existing Footpaths No. 574,575 and 568 at point **A** (Grid Reference 77306 74773) proceeding in a south-easterly direction for approximately 70 metres to point **B** (Grid Reference 77375 74763).

The width of Footpath Number 569 is unclear between points **A** and **B** on the ground.

PART 2

Description of Site of New Path or Way

The proposed new route commencing in the Parish of Bewdley at the junction with the existing Footpath No. 575 at point **C** (Grid Reference 77306 74753) proceeding in an easterly direction for approximately 70 metres to meet with footpath No. 569 again at point **B** (Grid Reference 77375 74763).

The width of Footpath Number 569 is 2 metres.
