CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

- CCTV will be installed and working to the satisfaction of the Police
- Recordings will be maintained for an appropriate time which in this case will be 28 days
- Alcohol and other drinks will be served in plastic or toughened glass
- All bottles and glasses will be removed from the outside areas to the front of the premises as soon as they are finished with or are empty
- Will be members of Pub Watch Radio scheme that provides two way communication between licensed premises in Bewdley when it is in operation
- The equipment will be on at all times when the premises are open to the public, and will be monitored by the Designated Premises Supervisor or other responsible member of staff
- All inclusive nights or other irresponsible drinks promotions are not to be permitted
- The premises will be a member of Pub Watch and a representative will attend the Pub Watch meetings and participate in the initiatives
- No unaccompanied children are allowed on the premises
- Doors and windows to be kept closed (except for access to and egress from the premises) during regulated entertainment
- Staff will undertake regular noise checks which will take place during any regulated entertainment to ensure no noise nuisance is caused
- Notices will be displayed asking customers to respect the neighbours and leave the premises quietly
