Licence Application consultation – Angel Public House, 76 Load Street, Bewdley

I make representation with specific regard to the above and the requested provisions for regulated entertainment. The application requests live amplified music and recorded music to be performed outdoors between the hours of 10:00 – 23:00 7 days a week.

I am informed that residents have objected to this facet of the application and have made subsequent representation. As the Council's advisor on pollution matters I have been asked to give a professional opinion in relation to the potential for noise problems.

I am familiar with the location concerned, and the detail on the application. On this particular instance I must agree with the resident's objections, as it is very likely that holding of such events on the frontage and to the rear of the building are likely to cause noise problems.

Presently I am of the opinion that any licence premises in the town centre holding external amplified entertainments is unlikely to do so without causing material interference with the use and enjoyment of residential properties by the local people of Bewdley.
