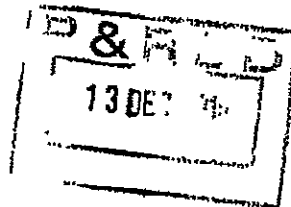

**Black Boy Hotel Kidderminster Road Bewdley Objection to Change in License**

I am writing to you on behalf of all the owners and residents of Brunel Mews Numbers 1 to 7, 16 Kidderminster Road and 2 Brunel Court who are members of the Association.

We wish to record our strong objection to any change or extension to the license of the Black Boy Hotel. Our objections are based on the following:

1. Excessive noise from the use in the past of the unlicensed barn which will no doubt be even worse should its future use be allowed.
2. Noise and anti social behaviour of customers leaving very late at night or early in the morning.
3. Failure of the management to heed the concerns of the residents in the past with no attempt to control the noise and behaviour of customers.
4. Blocking of the public right of way at the rear of the hotel with a marquee.
5. Noise from the increased numbers of cars using the restricted access to the Hotel car park.
6. Unauthorised parking by customers of the Hotel on the private car park belonging to the Brunel Mews Residents Company Ltd
