Section 12 Contract Procedure Rules

Due to the changes to procurement procedures brought in by The Public Contracts Regulations 2015 and the implementation of an electronic procurement system it is necessary to amend the Contract Procedure Rules. The below table sets out the proposed key amendments, including those which are suggested due to the need to simplify procedures for efficiency. Minor amendments have not been detailed below but are available on request. Changes to take effect from 26th May 2016.
