Recommendations from the Overview and Scrutiny Committee Thursday 7th October 2021

Wyre Forest Local Plan (2016-2036)

The Committee considered a draft of a Cabinet report from the Corporate Director: Economic Prosperity and Place which informed Members of the progress with the examination of the new Local Plan and sought approval to conduct a public consultation upon the Inspector's Schedule of Proposed Main Modifications to the Plan and documentation produced under delegated authority. The Committee also considered the recommendations from the Local Plans Review Panel meeting of the 6th October 2021.

The Committee discussed the report in detail and the recommendations were passed by a majority of the Committee.

Recommend to Cabinet:

The Overview & Scrutiny Committee recommend that Cabinet AGREE the following:

- 2.1 To approve the Inspector's Schedule of Proposed Main Modifications to the Wyre Forest District Local Plan (2016-2036) (ED57) and the subsequent changes to the Policies Map (ED59) (together with the associated supporting documents, including the Sustainability Appraisal (ED58)) (all documents listed in Appendix 1) for the purposes of the statutory consultation.
- 2.2 That the Corporate Director: Economic Prosperity & Place be authorised to conduct a public consultation including 4-6 public roadshows/events in a variety of locations across the District on the Inspector's Schedule of Proposed Main Modifications and the relevant supporting documents, including the Sustainability Appraisal.
- 2.3 To delegate authority to the Corporate Director: Economic Prosperity & Place in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Economic Regeneration, Planning and Localism to make any such necessary arrangements for that consultation including final review of any detailed modifications issued by the Inspector.
