<b>Reason for the decision/alternatives considered</b>	<p>The Strong Leader Report dated 10/06/22 gave authority for the Head of Community and Environment Services in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Culture, Leisure and Community Safety to determine whether to proceed with disposal of assets following the advertisement of the intended disposal of any land which was classified as 'open space' and to consider any objections in relation to the following land. These are proposed to be transferred to Kidderminster Town Council as part of the Localism proposals; the sites are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Baxter Gardens, Birmingham Road, Kidderminster, DY10 2BX</li><li>• Broadwaters Park, Broadwaters Drive, Kidderminster, DY10 2RY</li><li>• St George's Park, Radford Ave, Kidderminster, DY10 2ES</li></ul> <p>The advert was placed in the Kidderminster Shuttle for 2 weeks (23/06/22 and 30/06/22) and no objections were received so it is decided that the disposal is progressed subject to detail of the grant offer being agreed.</p>
