The Council's Homelessness and Rough Sleeping Strategy (2023-2025) has been developed to address homelessness prevention, intervention and recovery The revised published strategy has been considered by Members, partners, the Local Homelessness Forum and the general public.
	The consultation responses have been considered and amendments have been made to the strategy to reflect these. The proposed strategy can therefore be adopted
	forthwith.
