DECISION OF LICENSING SUB-COMMITTEE held on 10 April 2024

Having carefully considered the application by Passey Food LTD to grant a premises licence in respect of 106 Minster Road, Stourport on Severn, DY13 8AB the Licensing Sub-Committee has decided to grant the application in respect of 106 Minster Road, Stourport on Severn, DY13 8AB in the form agreed between the Applicant and the Police during the consultation period (and circulated before the hearing) subject to the following condition:

The Applicant shall make an e-mail address available for the Residents within the vicinity of the licensed premises. The Applicant shall maintain an e-mail list for the Residents and shall provide the Residents with periodic updates on upcoming events.

And the reasons for the Sub-Committee's decision are as follows:

- 1. The residential character of the area and the very close proximity of a large number of residential properties to the premises and the impact, raised in representations, on the living amenity of the people who are living in the area surrounding the premises, including the effect of the increased demand for parking in the immediate area of the premises on the local Residents and disturbance of sleep, means there is a strong possibility one of the four statutory licensing objectives will be compromised; namely the prevention of public nuisance.
- The condition offered to the Sub-Committee by the Applicant during the hearing was considered appropriate to address the concerns raised in the representations and to protect the amenity of the Residents within the vicinity of the Licensed Premises and has been duly adopted.

- 3. In coming to this decision, the Sub-Committee has specifically considered the requirements of:
 - a. paragraphs 6.24, 6.25, 6.26, 6.27, 6.28 and 6.29 of the Council's Licensing Policy; and paragraphs 6.11, 6.12, 6.13, 6.15, 6.16, 6.17 and 6. of the council's Licensing Policy
 - b. paragraphs 8.2 and 8.3 of the Council's Licensing Policy; and
 - c. paragraphs 2.21 to 2.25 and 2.27 of the section 182 Guidance (December 2023).
